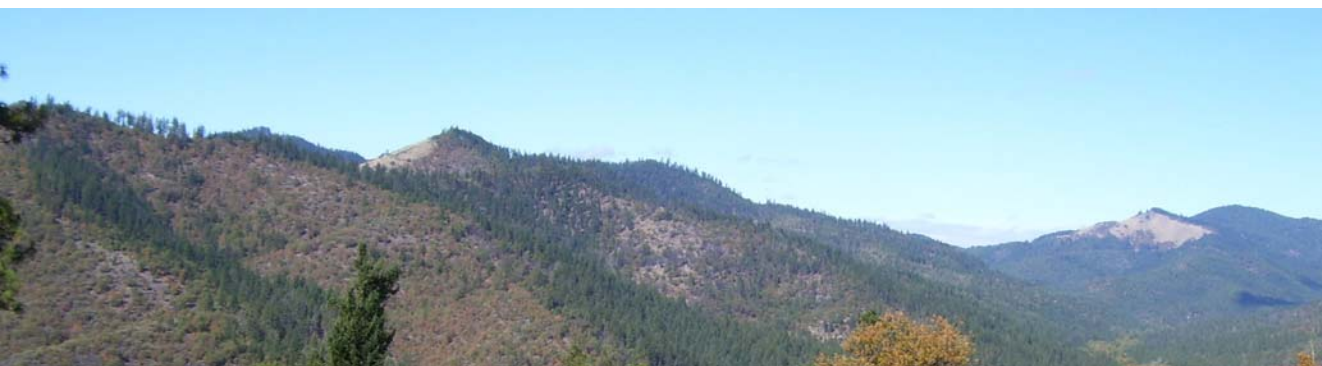
Develop your Forest Management Plan

The Master Woodland Manager (MWM) program helps you learn how to "read" your woodland by understanding local ecological factors, such as soil, historic land use, tree and plant species, wildlife, insects and fire ecology. It gives you the tools to conduct assessments to determine where your woodland is heading as it grows and matures. You will also learn how various management activities will help you meet your long term vision for the property.
